- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means a graduate who, beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose

employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completed an application educational program.

- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later. Cancellation shall occur when student gives written notice of cancellation at the address of the School shown on the top of the first page of the Enrollment Agreement, by mail, hand delivery or telegram. If the school has gives any equipment, including books or other materials the student shall return them to the school within thirty days following the date of your Notice of Cancellation.

If student fails to return this equipment, including books and other materials, in good condition within the thirty (30) day period, the School may deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due to you. If you cancel this Agreement as required, the School will refund any money that you paid, less any deduction for equipment not timely returned in good condition, within thirty days after your Notice of Cancellation is received.

If the student receives federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitles to a refund of the money not paid from federal financial aid funds.
